We learn about celebrating and mark **festivals** that are relevant to our community and our curriculum. We hold whole school assemblies to share this with each other and parents. These include, but are not limited to: Eid ul-Fitr and Eid al-Adha; Divali or Holi; Chinese New Year; Birthday of Guru Nanak; Advent/Christmas and Easter.

During Multicultural Arts and Faith Week (which is held in summer every other year) children make **visits to local places of worship** and meet a variety of religious leaders in whole school assemblies, etc. They also encounter arts and cultures and make links to world religions.
