As you and your children may have seen in the news (https://www.bbc.co.uk/newsround/articles/c784lwpyx7qo) there is to be a new drive to ensure all schools have libraries because, sadly, many schools do not have libraries like ours or a librarian like Janie! For us, access to these books for information and pleasure are a vital part of school life and visiting each week helps build good habits for life. We know

that family life can be very busy, but we would love it if you could prioritise making sure library books are returned. Not only does this mean your child can take home a different book, but any that we lose and have to replace mean less money in the library budget to buy new books that the children will love. (For some children, the books from school are their only

regular source of reading materials.) To help with planning, please note that these are the usual library days:

Wednesday – Reception Class, Year 3 and Year 4

Thursday – Year 1, Year 2 and Year 5. (Year 6 choose books independently throughout the week.) Many families find keeping the book in the book bag when not being read helps to ensure it always goes back and forth to school. Thank you for your help in keeping our library so well stocked and inviting. (Honestly, when I visit other schools – including some secondary schools – I am always so grateful for the quality of our library, the work Janie does and how it is so central in our school.)

It is nearly time for the first ever FOSOPS AGM on Wednesday next week. Please come along to support the work of our PTA that support our school with fundraising and also with social events like the Woodland Walk -> They are planning a big social fundraiser too – save the date notice overleaf.
