**Dear Parents and Carers** 

A stormy week\* comes to the close and was marked this morning with a lovely **class assembly** by Y1. We particularly enjoyed their talk for writing and the learning they shared about the senses in their Body Song as well as their performance of AA Milne's poem, Now We Are Six.

We have had a number of inspiring assemblies this week. On Monday our assembly was led by **Leeds Rhinos** who were encouraging the children to adopt healthy lifestyles. On Wednesday

we were visited by **Energy Heroes** who shared messages about climate change and the environment with the whole school. They then went to work with Year 5 on a lesson that used maths and science to explore data linked to energy and climate change.

This week was punctuated by a Training Day on Tuesday. There are five statutory training days throughout the school year that we are directed by the government to use for staff development. The main focus for this training day was **Paediatric First Aid training**. Having a number of staff in school trained gives us more flexibility to offer trips, wraparound care, etc. and it was good to have a refresher.

There have been recent localised outbreaks of measles centred around the West Midlands. There is a risk of further outbreaks in other areas unless urgent action is taken to increase Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccination take up in areas with low MMR vaccine rates. Measles spreads very easily among those who are unvaccinated, especially in nurseries and schools. The best protection against measles for children and adults is to get both doses of the MMR vaccine.
