

Dear Parents and Carers

They explored the idea of a fair test and came up with an experiment to find out which rocks are the most permeable, from chalk to marble. Granite was the preferred choice of most of the scientists. Y3 are very interested in geology and vulcanology at the moment and enjoyed a special visit earlier this week from one of our dads who is an expert in this field!
