Children in Reception, Year One, Year Two, Year Four and Year 6 will have had additional **statutory assessment** information accompanying their child's end of year report. These online guides (below) by the Department for Education explain more about them. At Shire Oak we deliberately



keep these tests and checks as low key as possible (and children in KS1 do not know they are doing them.) Hopefully the drop-in parents' evenings last Wednesday gave the opportunity to discuss what the results mean for your child, if there was any uncertainty. The information in these DfE guides will be broadly the same for next year other than us not knowing what the pass mark will be for the phonics screening check until after all data is submitted and the KS1 SATs being discontinued. (This year the pass mark for phonics was 32. Any child scoring below that will continue to receive support in phonics learning and will take the check again next year in Year 2.) 
