

Letter 24 15th March 2024

Dear Parents and Carers



Thank you so much to Mr Chris Marshall for organising a great **Science Week** in school. As well as a fun assembly to kick the week off, we enjoyed special scientist visitors from Hands-on Science leading a workshop in each class. These were YR: Fingerprints Y1: Kitten Rescue Y2: CSI Biometrics Y3: Massive magnets Y4: Firework science Y5: Elastic racers Y6: Circulation and the heart. We have also been taking part in a whole school challenge to see who can make a piece of paper travel the furthest – there have been some very inventive solutions so far! As I write we are looking forward to today's **Science Fair** with its chance to showcase science learning, experiments and investigations from each class.

Leeds City Council want to hear from residents in Headingley & Hyde Park, Little London & Woodhouse, and Weetwood on any issues related to **travel in your community**. This could be about how you access public transport facilities, whether you feel unsafe walking, wheeling or cycling, the attractiveness of a street, or where traffic and speeding are causing issues. Whilst on the subject of travel, please remember to **drive and park considerately around school**. In order to enable as many families (and older KS2 children on their own) to walk to and from school it is important that we make sure visibility for crossing the road is good and that there aren't any unpredictable driver behaviours! Our children are still learning road sense, so need all the help they can get to practise in a safe environment. I have also heard from the residents of High Wood Court (opposite our pedestrian gate) that parents are parking in their private parking area and at the entrance. This has prevented residents from parking but also from leaving in their cars or having ambulances attend (there are residents managing serious illnesses). Damage has been caused to the grass verge and possibly also to cars. They are considering their next steps, including a clamping service and police involvement, but I hope we can resolve this for the sake of our community without such intervention. (Stay and Play attendance may need more planning as that is a particular hotspot for parking issues.)

On Monday Y6 enjoyed a special visit to Lawnswood School to watch the technical dress rehearsal of their production of **Beauty and the Beast**. It was great to be able see so many former Shire Oak pupils involved in acting, playing music and hosting and to see how much work goes into pulling off such a great performance. It is always helpful that our older children get to visit local secondary schools before they make that transition so that they can see the positives about their next steps.

Year 3 enjoyed a special **sports festival** at Leeds University yesterday and made good use of the sports hall, equipment and coaches' input. They did well travelling on the bus and were good ambassadors for school.


