Our topic

This term our topic is Extreme Earth. This wide ranging topic provides us with the opportunity to investigate the fine details of rocks and soils along with exploring the big picture areas of mountain ranges and volcanoes. You will have already received the information about our exciting visit to Magna in the second part of the summer term.

English

In English we begin by exploring the different aspects of narrative writing before moving on to look at forms of poetry just before we launch Reading Week in the last week of the term. Our regular spelling lists will continue to come home as we work on suffixes, homophones (hear/here) and near homophones (accept/except).

Maths

In maths we will begin by doing further work on division before moving on to explore patterns and algebra. We will naturally be working on our base foundation knowledge with our Maths Passports. As a class our times table focus this term is the 9 X table. Thank you for the additional work in this area put in at home as it always helps the children's learning.
